1. What cookies are

Cookies are small text files stored on your computer, tablet, or mobile phone as you browse our website. In any case, we could not verify your personal identity from cookies.

They are not harmful to your devices (such as virus or malicious code) and allow you to use many of the useful features of our website (as we remember your favourites).

Cookies have a certain lifetime. Some cookies last until you close your browser or a short time. These are called "session cookies". Some last longer, for example, to allow a website to recognize you when you return to it. These are called 'persistent cookies'.

Cookies are placed directly by a website owner (like us) are known as 'first party cookies', and most modern websites also use technology provided by other people / businesses, for example, to provide online advertising. Cookies that have been placed by other parties are known as 'third-party cookies'.

In essence, cookies allow websites to store various anonymous information such as visitor's preferences or visit the site again

How Do We Use Cookies?

In Papantoniou we use the following cookies:

Functionality Cookies

Cookies allow our website to memorize your choices (such as your username, language, or region) and provide improved, more personal features. These cookies can remember the changes you've made to text size, fonts, and other webpages you can customize. They can also be used to provide services you have requested, such as watching a video or leaving a comment on our website.

Performance cookies

This particular category of cookies collects information about how we use our website such as which pages you visit more often and whether you have received an error message. Cookies are also used to compile anonymous traffic statistics and also know how you discovered our web pages. By using these cookies, we are able to collect information to improve your navigation experience on our website.

Targeting or advertising cookies

These cookies are used to better target our online advertising campaign, shaping a clearer picture of your preferences. Cookies can limit the frequency you see an advertisement and helping us to assess the effectiveness of our campaign. These cookies remember that you've visited a website and can share this information with other agencies or advertisers. Regularly targeting or advertising cookies will be linked to the functionality of the site provided by the other organization.
